APRIL 1ST : TRANSFER AIRPORT – HOTEL IN LIMA

Upon arrival at the International Airport in Lima, you will be warmly welcomed and transferred to your hotel. Depending on your arrival time, the remainder of the day will be at your leisure for rest and relaxation.

APRIL 2ND : CITY TOUR IN LIMA + WELCOME DINNER

We will meet in the hotel lobby at **8:50 AM**.

This morning, we will begin with a **guided walking tour of Colonial Lima**, once the capital of the Viceroyalty of Peru.

You will explore the city's historic center and admire over fifty colonial landmarks and monuments, including the **Paseo de la República, San Martín Square, Main Square, Government Palace, Archbishop's Palace, and the Cathedral Basilica**.

The tour continues with a visit to the **Monumental Convent of San Francisco**, where you will explore its famous **catcombs**, a remarkable example of colonial religious architecture and history.

Following the tour of downtown Lima, we will return to the hotel for some rest.

At approximately **7:00 PM**, you will be picked up for a **welcome dinner** at the renowned **Huaca Pucllana Restaurant**.

Located within the archaeological complex of the same name, Huaca Pucllana proudly upholds a culinary philosophy rooted in traditional **Peruvian flavors**, interpreted through **classical techniques** and **contemporary styles** to satisfy the most refined palates.

With the visionary support of Arturo Rubio and the culinary expertise of chefs **Marilú Madueño** and **Andrea Massaro**, the restaurant presents a modern take on Peruvian cuisine, showcasing the country's diverse ingredients—from fresh seafood and coastal fish to the vibrant range of native vegetables, rich in color, texture, and flavor.

After dinner, we will return to the hotel.

APRIL 3RD : LIMA – CUSCO

After breakfast, you will have time to rest, recover, and prepare your luggage for the next stage of the journey. Please ensure that you check out of the hotel on time.

Upon arrival in **Cusco**, the historic capital of the Inca Empire, we will transfer to our hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is reserved for **rest and acclimatization**, as Cusco is situated at an altitude of **11,152 feet (3,399 meters)** above sea level, surrounded by the majestic Andes Mountains.

Enjoy a peaceful evening and take this time to adjust to the high altitude.

APRIL 4TH : COOKING CLASS AND CITY TOUR CUSCO :

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will begin our day at approximately **9:30 AM** with a short **10-minute walk** to the restaurant where we will take part in a **Peruvian cooking class**.

Located in the heart of **San Blas**, one of Cusco's most vibrant and artistic neighborhoods, the restaurant offers a warm and elegant setting. With its rustic charm, refined decor, and colonial-style patio, the venue provides a truly unique and inviting atmosphere. It is renowned for serving a wide variety of traditional Peruvian dishes in both indoor and outdoor settings.

Peruvian Cooking Class Experience (Approx. 2 Hours)

- The experience begins and ends at your hotel in Cusco.
- You will receive a **live cooking demonstration**, where expert chefs will showcase the preparation of traditional Andean cuisine using fresh, local ingredients.
- You will gain insights into the unique flavors and culinary traditions that make Peruvian cuisine internationally celebrated.
- The class concludes with an opportunity to **enjoy the delicious dishes** prepared during the session.

At approximately **12:30 PM**, we will continue with a **guided City Tour of Cusco**.

Cusco City Tour Highlights:

- **Koricancha Temple** – Once the most important temple in the Inca Empire, dedicated to the Sun God, later converted into the Convent of Santo Domingo.
- **Plaza de Armas** – The city's main square, surrounded by colonial arcades, historic buildings, and vibrant culture.
- **Cusco Cathedral Basilica** – A magnificent 16th-century Catholic cathedral known for its art and architecture.
- **Sacsayhuamán Fortress** – A striking example of Inca military architecture with massive stone walls.
- **Qenko Archaeological Site** – A ceremonial center featuring carved rock formations and subterranean altars.

Following the tour, we will return to the hotel.

The remainder of the day is at your leisure to explore the city further, shop for local crafts, or simply rest and acclimate.

MEALS: BREAKFAST AND LUNCH DURING COOKING CLASS.

APRIL 5TH : SACRED VALLEY OF THE INCAS EXCURSION AND OVERNIGHT IN URUBAMBA

We will begin the day with an **early breakfast** at the hotel.

At **9:00 AM**, we depart for a full-day **excursion to the Sacred Valley of the Incas**, where you will explore some of the most important archaeological and cultural sites of the Inca civilization.

Excursion Highlights:

- **Pisac Archaeological Site & Handicraft Market**

Our first stop will be the **Pisac ruins**, where you will see remarkable Inca structures including religious temples and agricultural terraces.

We will also visit the **traditional handicraft market**, which operates on **Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays**. Here, you can experience the vibrant local culture, shop for handmade goods, and observe the customs of the local Quechua-speaking people. On Sundays, a **mass in Quechua** is celebrated at the local church, offering a unique cultural experience.

- **Lunch in Urubamba**

We will continue our journey through the Sacred Valley to the town of **Urubamba**, where we will stop to enjoy a **traditional lunch** featuring regional Andean cuisine.

- **Ollantaytambo Archaeological Complex**

In the afternoon, we will visit the **town of Ollantaytambo**, known for its impressive **Inca terraces, temples, and the fortress** that overlooks the town. This site played a significant role during the resistance against the Spanish conquest.

After completing our visit, we will transfer to our **hotel in Urubamba**, where we will spend the night. This location is strategically closer to the train station for our journey to Machu Picchu the following day.

- Please **pack a small backpack** and/or **carry-on bag** for **one night** in Urubamba.
- Your **main suitcase** will remain securely stored at the Cusco hotel, where we will return the next day.
- We recommend bringing:

 - **Sunblock**

APRIL 6TH : THE CITADEL OF MACHU PICCHU VISA VISTADOME AND RETURN ON HIRAM BINGHAM TRAIN

We begin the day with an **early breakfast at the hotel**.

At approximately **6:45 AM**, we will transfer to the train station to board the **Vistadome Observatory Train to Aguas Calientes**—the gateway to Machu Picchu.

Vistadome Observatory Train Experience

Upon arrival in **Aguas Calientes**, we will board a **shuttle bus for a 30-minute ride** up to **Machu Picchu**.

- Agricultural Zone
- Urban Zone
- The Guardhouse and Cemetery
- Ritual Rock
- Temple of the Sun

- Sacred Fountains and ceremonial doorways

Your guide will provide deep insight into the **history, architecture, and spiritual significance** of this UNESCO World Heritage Site.
